

Amendment to Ordinance #115 – Establishing Regulations for Recreational Vehicles (03/18/24)

Amendment to Section 5: Standards C

Recreational vehicles that are in sound working condition, can easily be moved, and have a current registration, shall not be considered an Accessory Use when located on a property with a Principal Permitted Use. Recreational vehicles not considered an Accessory Use shall be allowed on private property without a Principal Permitted Use for a maximum of thirty (30) days. Said RV in this situation shall have a maximum continuous occupancy of fifteen (15) days. After thirty (30) days on a property without a Principal Permitted Use, the Recreational Vehicle must be removed and not returned to the property within thirty (30) days. The Township must be notified, by the owner

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
